**Household Hazardous Waste Accepted:** Acids, Aerosols, Antifreeze, Cleaning chemicals, Batteries, Fluorescent light bulbs, Drain openers, Fertilizer, Pesticides, Motor oil and transmission fluids, Varnish and stains, Solvents/thinners and furniture stripper, Lighter fluid, Windshield wiper and brake fluids, Moth balls, Wood preservatives, Oil-based paint (NO latex paint), Poisons, Mercury thermometers and mercury containing devices

**Electronics recycling acceptable items:** Audio/visual equipment, Hard drives, Camcorders, Memory chips, CD Rom drives, Network/ Video/Sound cards, cell phones and pagers, Power supplies, Computers and monitors, Scrap computer plastic and metal, Connectors/Cord /Wire, Tape drives and audio cassettes, Small fax machines and household printers, VCRs, CDs/DVDs and VCR tapes, Floppy drives, Video games & Software
