Construction in the Neighborhood. A number of neighbors have sued DCRA over its allowing the subdivision of the lot at 2910 Garfield St, which would permit a developer to build two large houses in place of the one house that is there now. This lawsuit is in addition to the BZA appeal of that decision brought by ANC3C, WPCA and several neighbors. The plaintiffs in the court case asked the court to issue a preliminary injunction to maintain the status quo while the litigation proceeds. At a status conference today, the Judge entered an order which prohibits the developer from taking down the large trees on the property or razing the existing house until 15 business days after DCRA issues the permits to build the new houses. She also required DCRA to give plaintiffs and the Court written notice of the issuance of such permits. A hearing on the preliminary injunction motion is set for September 17.
