WPCA elections will take place in November. If you want to get more involved in your neighborhood, one good way to do it is to get more involved in your neighborhood association. The terms of all four officers (president, VP, secretary and treasurer) and three at-large Board members expire with the upcoming elections. In addition, there is a vacant at-large position which will be filled in this election. The Executive Committee has named [Sarah Taber](#) to head the Nominations Committee for these elections. It is the job of that committee to get the names of people interested in running (and those nominated by others), verify their eligibility and report the names of all the candidates to the Executive Committee. Councilmember Mary Cheh's 4th Annual "**Back to School BBQ**" will be at Friendship "Turtle" Park next Saturday, September 25 from 11 am to 3 pm. The developer of the two houses to be built at **2910 Garfield St** has filed an application to build retaining walls for the houses in the "public space" around its property. It also wants permission to extend to stoops and steps into public space. If the City denies these requests, the houses the developer will be able to build will have to be lower and set back further from the street. The hearing on these applications before the DDoT Public Space Committee is on October 28. The hearing on the appeal to the Board of Zoning Adjustment (by ANC3C, WPCA and five neighbors) to reverse the subdivision of this property into two lots is on October 5. Details [on our website](#).
