The **WPCA Fall meeting** will be on Tuesday October 16th at 7:30 pm at Stanford. The featured speakers will be from the DC Office of Planning to discuss its **proposed changes to the District's zoning rules**, with emphasis on what will — and will not — change in Woodley Park. There will be time to ask questions and to tell OP what you think.

WPCA elections will also take place at the October 16th meeting. If you want to get more involved in your neighborhood, one good way to do it is to get more involved in your neighborhood association. The terms of all four officers (president, VP, secretary and treasurer) and three at-large Board members expire with the upcoming elections. Sarah Taber, Bruce Forrest and Zev Lewis are the Nominations Committee for these elections. It is their job to collect the names of people interested in running (and those nominated by others), verify their eligibility and report the names of all the candidates to the Executive Committee. Saturday October 20th is the date for the **Woodley Park historical talk and walking tour**. We'll meet at 1 pm for the talk and some light refreshments. The developer who has completed two other projects in the neighborhood is proposing a third one, at **2852 Connecticut Ave**. The work would involve gutting the existing townhouse and dividing it into smaller units. In addition, he wants to build a four-story addition in the rear, creating a total of nine units. The proposal will be reviewed by the ANC and by HPRB next month.
