## Woodley Park News

Wednesday October 9, 7:30 pm at Stanford is the **WPCA Fall membership meeting**. The speaker will be Assistant Chief of the Metropolitan Police Department Diane Groomes, who will discuss crime in Woodley Park, MPD's strategy to address it and the latest neighborhood and city-wide MPD initiatives. WMATA is considering **combining close-together bus stops** to speed service and make it more reliable. Neighborhood stops that are being considered for elimination are stops for the 96 bus at 2601 Calvert St (westbound), 2727 29th St (northbound), 2745 29th St (southbound), 2931 Cathedral Ave (eastbound) and 2937 Cathedral Ave (westbound). At its September meeting, HPRB gave its approval to JBG's plans to convert to condos the **Wardman Tower** building of the Marriott Hotel. The plans described at the meeting had changed substantially from the ones originally submitted. In particular, JBG agreed not to have a driveway running from the front of the Tower down to Connecticut Avenue by the Metro elevator. The Board, however, did not approve JBG's request to enlarge the porte cochere at the Woodley Road entrance. Revised plans are [on the website](#).
