The **Maret School** described its planned additions at a neighborhood meeting last week. They are:

First, they want to fill in an area between the old gym and the Woodley mansion and make it a conference room. The historic building would not be touched, and the addition would not be visible from any street. They might try to do this as soon as the summer of 2014.

Second, they want to add a story to the small building that sits between Woodley and the larger academic building to the west. This would make this middle building the same height as the building to the west. The new floor would house several classrooms and a couple of offices. In connection with this project, Maret would ask the Board of Zoning Adjustment to increase its permitted enrollment by 15 students (to 650).

Finally, they would add an 18-foot tall structure behind the new gym off of Garfield St.

At this point, they would not undertake the second and third projects before 2015.
