The **WPCA Spring meeting** will be on Wednesday June 8 at 7 pm at Stanford. Representatives from DC's Historic Preservation Office will describe the historic preservation review process and answer questions. There will also be elections to fill three Executive Committee positions, which Nygel Williams, Jessica Wasserman and I currently hold by virtue of interim appointments. Finally, members will be asked to vote on proposed changes to [WPCA's bylaws](#) (section VI.D.):

~~D. No member may serve as President or Vice-President for more than three four consecutive terms or combine service in the two offices for more than four consecutive terms. No member may serve as an at-large member of the Executive Committee for more than six consecutive years. No member of the Executive Committee may concurrently serve as an ANC Commissioner.~~

A two-thirds vote is required for any change.

At the meeting to discuss the **draft design guidelines for historic district rowhouses**, it was pointed out that the existing guidelines are misleading where they suggest that "anything goes" in the rears -- language like the rears are of "insignificant importance from a historical perspective" -- and, at a minimum, that needs to be changed. A version of the guidelines with the misleading language stricken is [on the website](#). The Historic Design Guidelines Committee is reviewing its draft in light of the comments received at the meeting and by email.
