There will be a WPCA Executive Committee meeting on Wednesday July 12 to hear from Nancee Lyons of MuralsDC about a proposal for **a mural on the east side of Connecticut Ave.** 7:30 pm at Stanford. A full agenda should be [on the website](#) a few days before the meeting. All are welcome.

Last month, the WPCA Board unanimously voted to propose [amendments to the DC Comprehensive Plan](#). The amendments are designed to ensure that any re-development of the Marriott Wardman Park site be done pursuant to a comprehensive planning process and to make it harder to add another building to that site. At the ANC3C meeting this month, Commissioner Bole introduced a resolution supporting these proposals; it passed 5-3.

JBG reports that it does not have an agreement to sell the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel property.

The summer months can be rough on trees, especially newly planted trees. New trees need water twice per week for the first year, and once every two weeks for the next two years. There are a number of such trees in the neighborhood, especially west of Connecticut Ave. Urban Forestry has established a [tree tool](#) that identifies trees that might need watering and lets you record watering that you have done.
