The **McDonald's** architect continues to revise his client's design proposal for the Woodley Park location. The latest version is <u>on the website</u>. It shows that they want to replace the existing enclosure over the stairway. It appears, however, that the DC Building Code (DCMR 12A-3209, for anyone interested) generally prohibits encroachments of this sort into public space, and public space staff says that they can find no record of a permit for the current enclosure. I assume that McDonald's views a much-used uncovered stairway as a safety concern and might not undertake exterior renovations if it cannot replace the existing enclosure. The WPCA Board is interested in your views – do you favor an enclosure over the stairway or do you think it should be eliminated. Let me know what you think.
