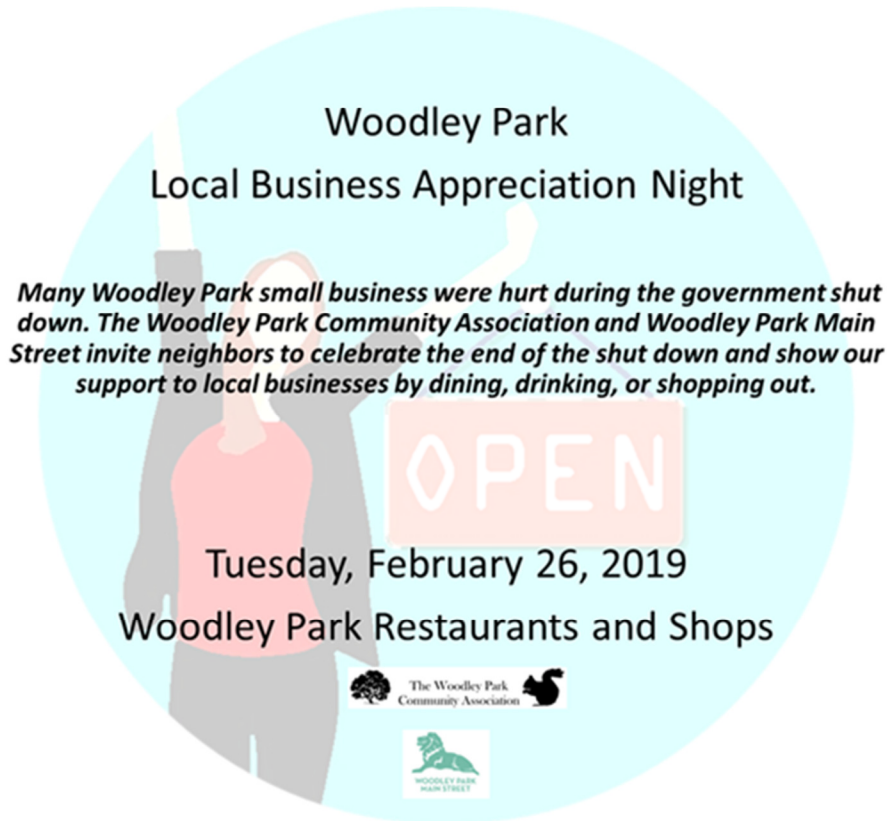

Save the date: The annual hazardous waste-shredding event will be in the morning on Saturday April 6. Details to follow.

Bike lanes. DDoT has indicated that it intends to install contra-flow bike lanes on Woodley Pl. (These are lanes in which the bicycle traffic goes in the opposite direction to vehicular traffic.) The existing vehicle travel lane would be reduced from 17 feet to the DC-standard 11 feet. No street parking would be lost.
