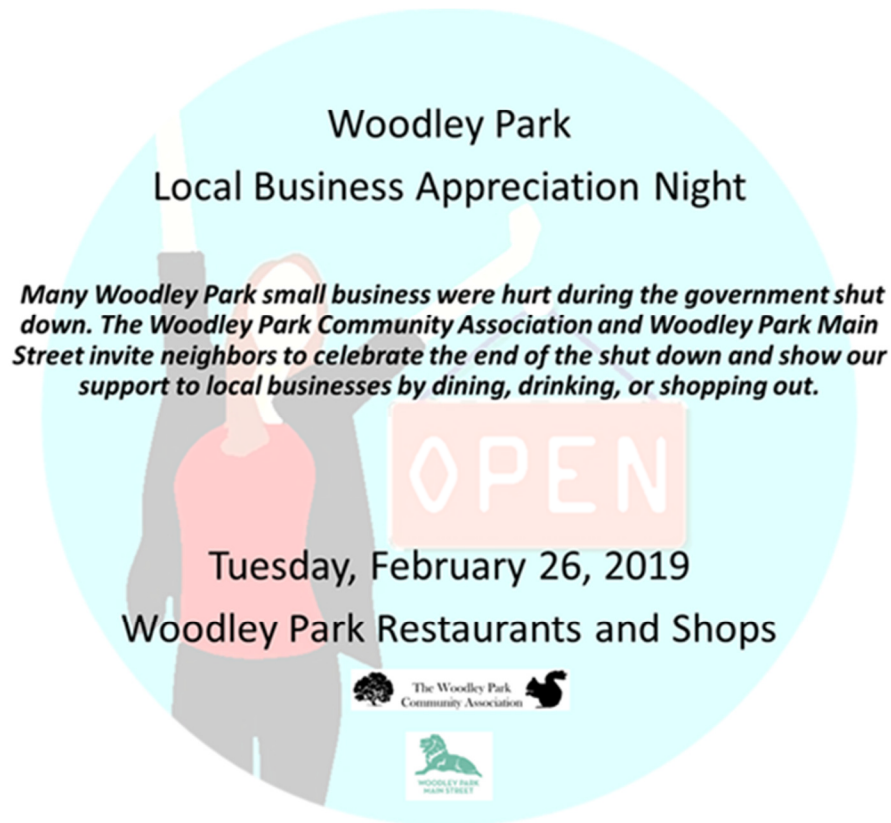


## Woodley Park News

**Bike lanes.** DDoT has indicated that it intends to install contra-flow bike lanes on Woodley Pl. (These are lanes in which the bicycle traffic goes in the opposite direction to vehicular traffic.) DDoT says that the existing vehicle travel lane would be reduced from 17 feet to the DC-standard 11 feet and that no street parking would be lost.
