Wardman Park. Carmel Partners, the new owner of the property, has applied to HPRB for concept approval of its proposed redevelopment. Even though Carmel's property is not historic, it is attached (and will continue to be attached) to the Wardman Tower, which is. Copies of the [application](#) and [design documents](#) are on the website.

Casey Trees has released the results of its [tree canopy survey](#) of the District. It found that, after years of increasing coverage, it declined 1% (to 37%) from the last survey. The City established a 2032 canopy goal of 40% in the [2013 Sustainability Plan](#).

Zoo hours have changed again. It will now be open Thursday through Sunday from 8 am to 3 pm. All visitors ages 2 and older are required to wear a mask in all indoor spaces, regardless of their vaccination status. Fully vaccinated visitors do not need to wear a mask in outdoor areas.
