## Woodley Park News

**Wardman Park.** Carmel Partners, the new owner of the property, will attend WPCA's Executive Committee meeting (details below) to answer some questions about its proposed redevelopment. This is not a substitute for the promised broad community meeting, which should occur next month. Copies of Carmel's HPRB [application](#) and [design documents](#) are on the website.

Also [on the website](#) is the proposal Carmel received this week to use one of the existing buildings on the site for **affordable housing**.

At its last meeting, ANC3C passed a [resolution](#) supporting the restoration of service on the **L1 bus line** on Connecticut Ave, which was suspended in March 2020 because of the pandemic. WMATA had advised the Commission that it needs to advocate for funding in the FY2023 budget if the service is to be restored. In support of that effort, the ANC is collecting signatures on an online petition, which you can access [here](#).

The next **Tuesday Talk** will feature two neighborhood experts to discuss how climate change and urban development have affected ecology in our local gardens and wildlife. Tamara Belt is a landscape designer and environmentalist and serves as Landscape Chair and Vice-Chair of Tregaron Conservancy.
