Wardman Park. At a hearing last week, HPRB told Carmel Partners, the new owner of the property, to engage further with the community about its plans. To that end, WPCA will host Carmel at a Zoom meeting on Thursday March 17 at 7:30 pm. The first part of the meeting will focus on the issue that is relevant to HPRB: compatibility of the proposed structures with the landmark Wardman Tower (*e.g.*, massing, materials, design, landscaping etc).
