Woodley Park News

DDoT has released drafts of detailed maps of Connecticut Ave, reconfigured to accommodate bike lanes. They show where parking will be removed, bus stop changes, pickup/dropoff locations etc. Maps of the [Woodley Park section](#) and the [full corridor](#) are on the website. DDoT will work to refine these maps in coming weeks.

Neighbors report a spike in stolen packages from porches and front steps. Be watchful.
