Wardman Park update. Carmel advises that the demolition of the hotel interior should be completed this month and that demolition of the buildings will begin in September. Carmel anticipates that the demolition phase will be completed by February 2023, at which time it will begin construction. Demolition will begin with the Park Tower building along Calvert St. Carmel will not use wrecking balls or dynamite implosion. Carmel's dust control plans are subject to review and approval by the DC Department of Energy & Environment.

McDonald's. The long-planned renovation of the Woodley Park McDonald's is scheduled to begin next month. The owner is asking DCRA for permission to do interior work late (until 9 pm) and on Sundays.
