**Parking in CP**. DDoT has issued its notice of intention to change the parking rules near the CP business district. The existing two-hour metered parking zones on the 3300-3400 blocks of Connecticut Avenue and adjacent streets (35 spaces) will become 30-minute metered parking zones. Nearby residential and unregulated parking zones will also become 30-minute metered areas. Shorter periods will increase turnover, giving more people access. However, 30 minutes isn't enough time for a meal or multiple errands. You can learn more and <u>tell DDoT what you think</u> by October 20.

**Rats** are a nagging problem in the neighborhood. Some neighbors put together <u>hints</u> on how you can help.

Work should begin later this week to restore the bricks on the exterior of the **Stanford building**. There will be scaffolding covering the sidewalk on the Woodley Rd side and some parking spaces will temporarily be lost to staging activities.
