As expected, OP's [Connecticut Avenue Development Guidelines](#) is on HPRB's agenda this week. However, the item is listed as an "informational presentation", not an item for Board action. OP and fans of the guidelines had wanted the Board to adopt the Guidelines as its own. You can watch the hearing [online](#), Thursday September 28 at 9 am.

ANC3C postponed its consideration of whether to support a **trash enclosure** on the public sidewalk behind McDonald's on 24th St until its October 16 meeting. But first it will be discussed at the ANC's Planning & Zoning Committee meeting on October 2 (meeting info [here](#)). You might remember the unsightly, rat-magnet trash enclosure that used to be in that location; the DC government ordered that it be removed in 2018 as part of the renovation of the restaurant. Parking in CP. DDoT has issued its notice of intention to change the parking rules near the CP business district. The existing two-hour metered parking zones on the 3300-3400 blocks of Connecticut Avenue and adjacent streets (35 spaces) will become 30-minute metered parking zones. Nearby residential and unregulated parking zones will also become 30-minute metered areas. Shorter periods will increase turnover, giving more people access. However, 30 minutes isn't enough time for a meal or multiple errands. You can learn more and [tell DDoT what you think](#) by October 20.
