DCPS boundary changes. DCPS has undertaken a comprehensive review of school boundaries and feeder patterns. It is considering shifting the boundary for Oyster, south from Cathedral Ave to Woodley Rd. Children starting school on these blocks (both east and west of Connecticut) would attend Eaton. WPCA opposes this proposal. There's <u>an online petition</u> opposing it. Or you can share your thoughts with <u>Chancellor Ferebee</u> and <u>Councilmember Frumin</u>. Information about this process is <u>online</u>.
