Last year, WMATA proposed a **new regionwide bus plan** that included the elimination of the 96 route that runs east-west through Woodley Park. WPCA, a number of our neighbors and others opposed this proposal. Last week, WMATA released its modified plan that includes the NW DC portion of the 96 route, renamed C55. The one downside is that the plan is for 30-minute headways, as opposed to the existing 20-minute weekday headways. You can see a route map [here](#) and a map of the full system [here](#). DDoT recently announced that it was dropping any plans for **bike lanes on Connecticut Ave.** Last week, the DC Council Transportation Committee issued a budget report recommending that all Connecticut Ave safety improvements be cancelled if they do not include bike lanes. Obviously, more to come.

Recent filings in the zoning appeal against the **Carmel Wardman Park project** are [on the website](#) (in one zip file). They include motions to dismiss the appeal by Carmel and the Dept of Buildings, appellants' opposition to those motions and prehearing statements from appellants, Carmel and DoB. The BZA will hear the appeals tomorrow, May 15.
