Woodley Park News

Connecticut Ave Rezoning. The DC Office of Planning is asking the Zoning Commission to change the zoning rules for Connecticut Ave. These changes would permit buildings up to 75 feet tall (plus a 15-foot penthouse) on the east side of Connecticut in Woodley Park, and 90 feet (plus penthouse) on the west side. Specific projects would need HPRB approval. The changes would allow for more residential development in these areas.

The Zoning Commission will hold a hearing on this proposal on December 1. You can sign up to testify here and can watch the hearing here.

Cannabis. Petit Monde is closing, and a cannabis retailer has applied for a license to move into that space. The applicant says the

proposed facility with approximately 1,500 square feet of space will provide cannabis flowers, cannabis concentrates, and a line of edible products and home delivery services to registered patients in Washington, D.C. The applicant is requesting delivery, Safe-Use Treatment Facility and Summer Garden endorsements.

ANC3C is able to protest this application. If you have an opinion, you can let your commissioner know (and can identify the person here).
