2649 Connecticut Ave. At its meeting this month, the WPCA Executive Committee adopted a resolution to accept the owner's renovation plans, and it will not oppose the Historic Preservation application. Several neighbors were concerned that the changes to the building would worsen the already difficult traffic conditions in the alley, and the Committee indicated that it would contact MPD to ask for better enforcement.
