Library. Now that review of the exterior design of the library has been completed, attention will be turned to the new library's interior. WPCA's Library Committee has prepared a series of suggestions for interior design. They expect that DCPL will have a community meeting to start the discussion of this subject in early June and wants to get these suggestions in early to help guide the conversation. At last evening's meeting, the Executive Committee named Jessica Wasserman to fill the vacancy on the Committee.

Also at that meeting, based on input received to date on **JBG's proposal for the Marriott property**, the Executive Committee voted to oppose JBG's request to upzone part of the property to high density residential and, therefore, to oppose the PUD application generally. We expect to have a meeting of the membership to help develop a fuller response after JBG formally files its application.
